Bush* (OUP, 2008). His research has been cited in Bloomberg, The Boston Globe, Forbes, The Guardian, The New York Times, The Wall Street Journal, The Washington Post, and other venues. He read for a B.A. (First Class) in Philosophy, Politics, and Economics at Oxford, where he was Scholar at Christ Church, awarded the Sara Norton Thesis Prize, and also completed his D. Phil in Politics. He was awarded the Presidency Research Fellowship and Founders' Award of the Presidency and Executive Politics Section of the American Political Science Association, and NUS's Annual Teaching Excellence Award for 2014/15 and 2015/16.
