Helmi Arman is a Director and Citi's Chief Economist for Indonesia, based in Jakarta. He joined Citi Research in 2011 from Bank Danamon Indonesia, where he was the Economist and bond market strategist from 2005 to 2008. Prior to that, Helmi was an Economist with Bahana Securities from 2004 to 2005, and before that, an Economist for the ASEAN Secretariat.

Since 2016, Helmi also became a faculty member at the Bank Indonesia Institute. He has written about the Indonesian financial markets in various books and stand-alone publications. Helmi was top ranked among economists covering Indonesia according to the 2018 and 2019 Institutional Investor All-Asia Research team survey. He was also consecutively ranked throughout 2013-2019 in The Asset benchmark survey.

Helmi graduated with a Bachelor's degree in Economics from Universitas Indonesia and holds an MSc degree in International Money & Banking from the University of Birmingham, UK, and a Master of Financial Economics degree from Katholieke Universiteit Leuven, Belgium.
